Surgical Hostess Service Begins



A new service by White Cross volunteer women was inaugurated at Parkview last month. Already it has proven to be most worthwhile and appreciated by family members or friends who await the progress of a patient undergoing surgery.

Surgical Hostesses, well versed in hospital procedure, are stationed in the hospital lobby. They are advised of all Surgeries being performed and are in contact with the Operating Room, Recovery Room and patient floor so they may provide current information to those waiting.

This of course is a most anxious period, particularly because it involves from 1 to 3 hours or more. Surgical patients are taken from the Operating Room to the Recovery Room before being returned to their floor. The Recovery Room is a "safety island" where the patient is under constant observation by nurses with special training in post-operative care.

Visitors including family members cannot be permitted in these areas but may rest assured they will be advised of the patient's condition as they wait in the lobby.

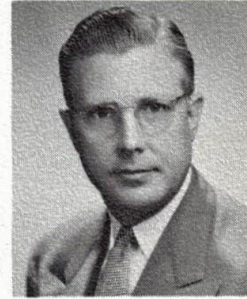

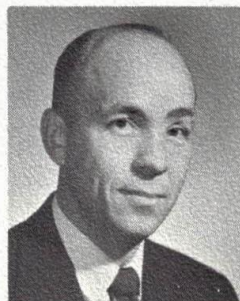

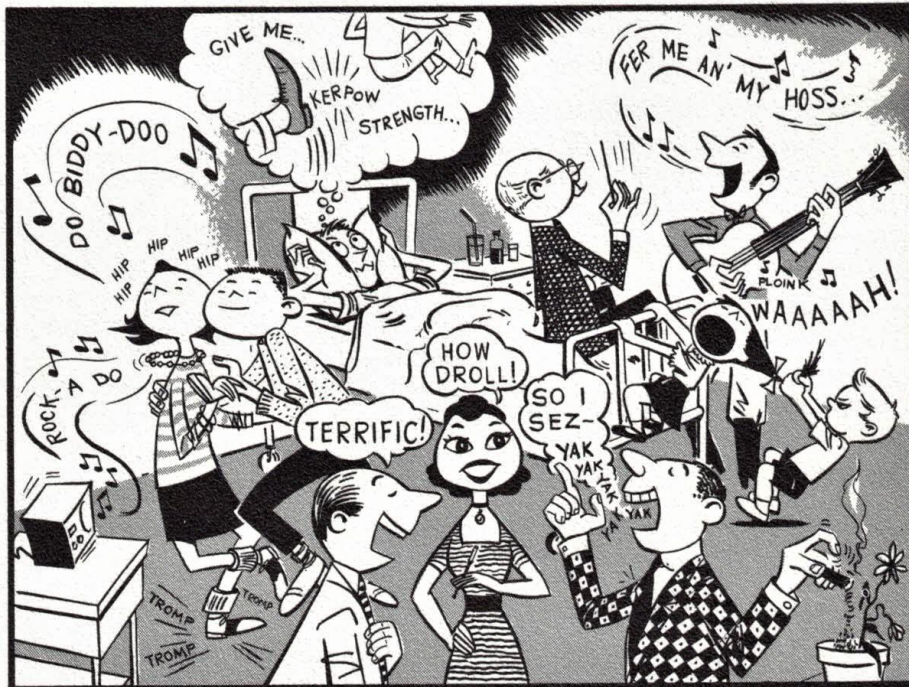
